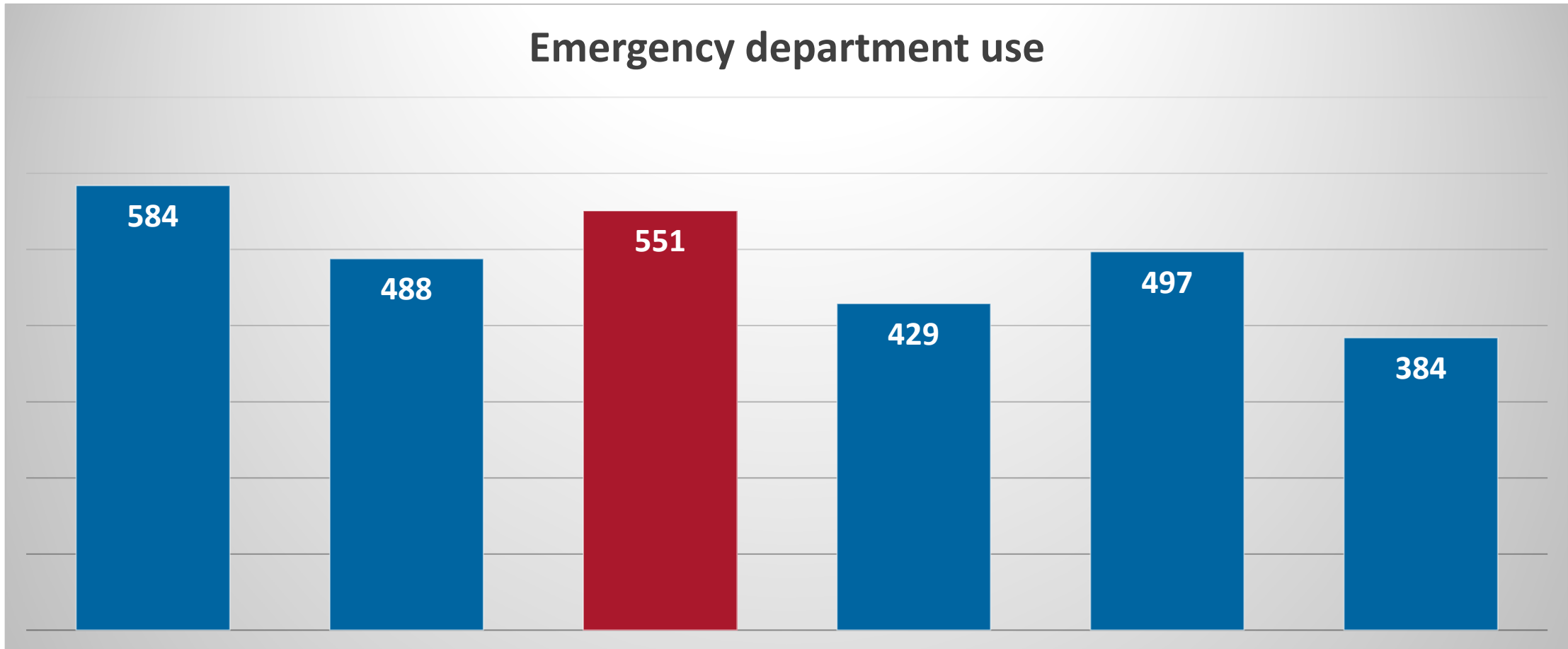

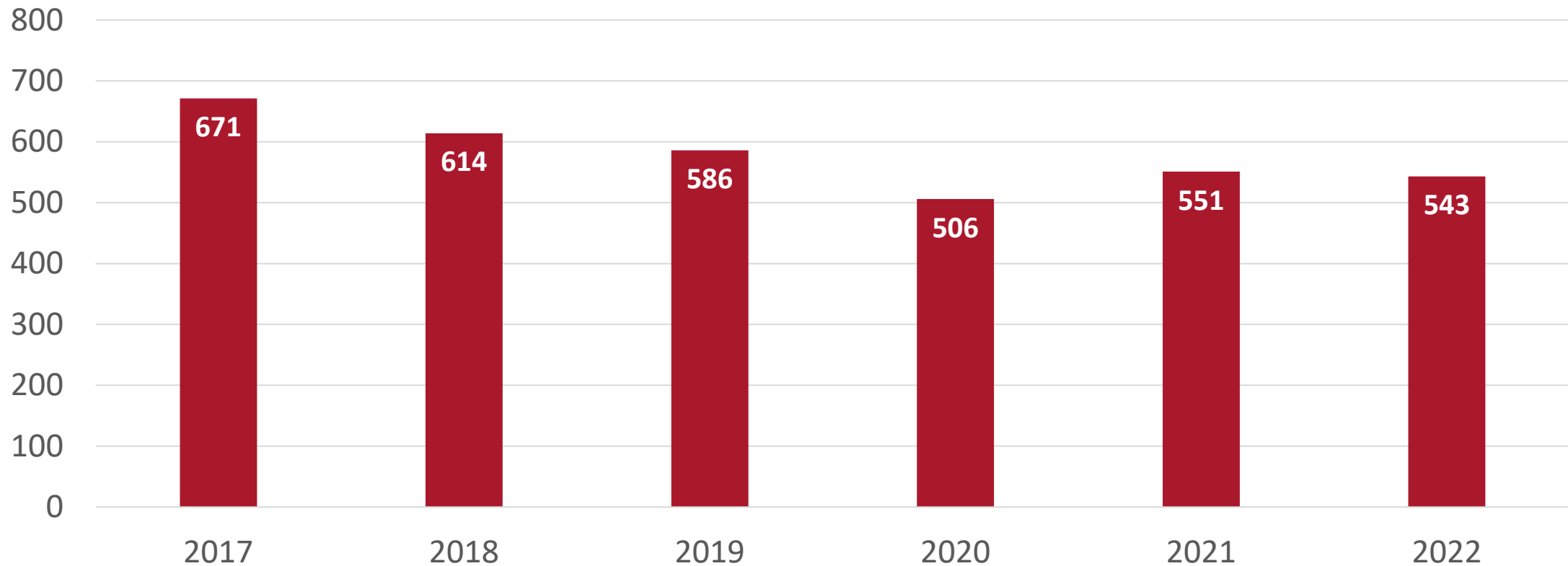
2021 Emergency department visits per 1000

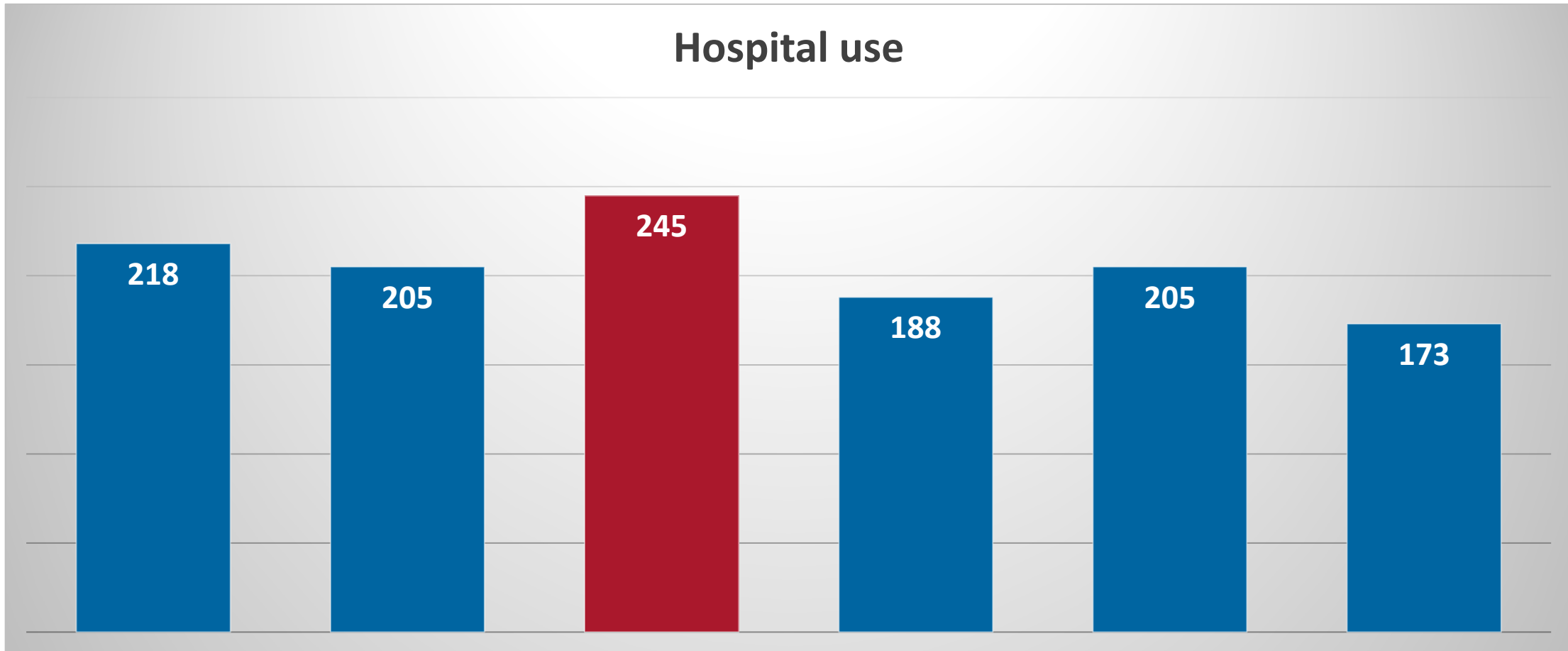

ED visits per 1,000

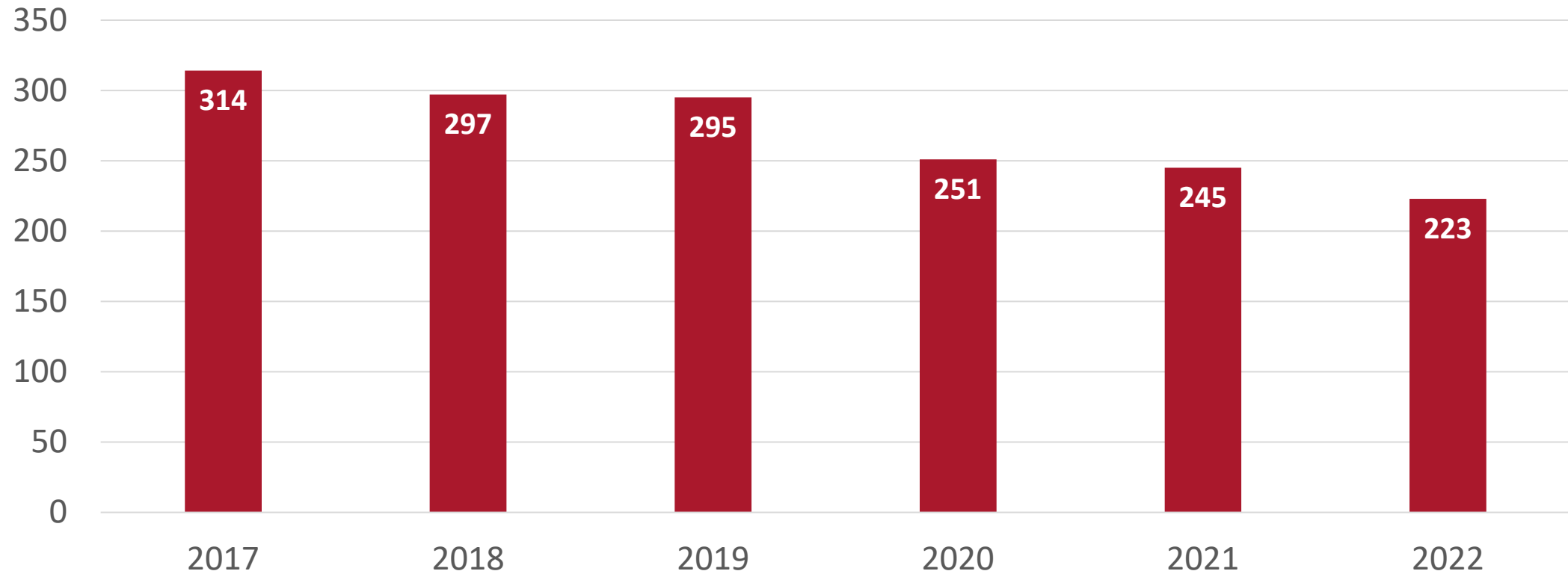


2021 Acute hospital admissions per 1000

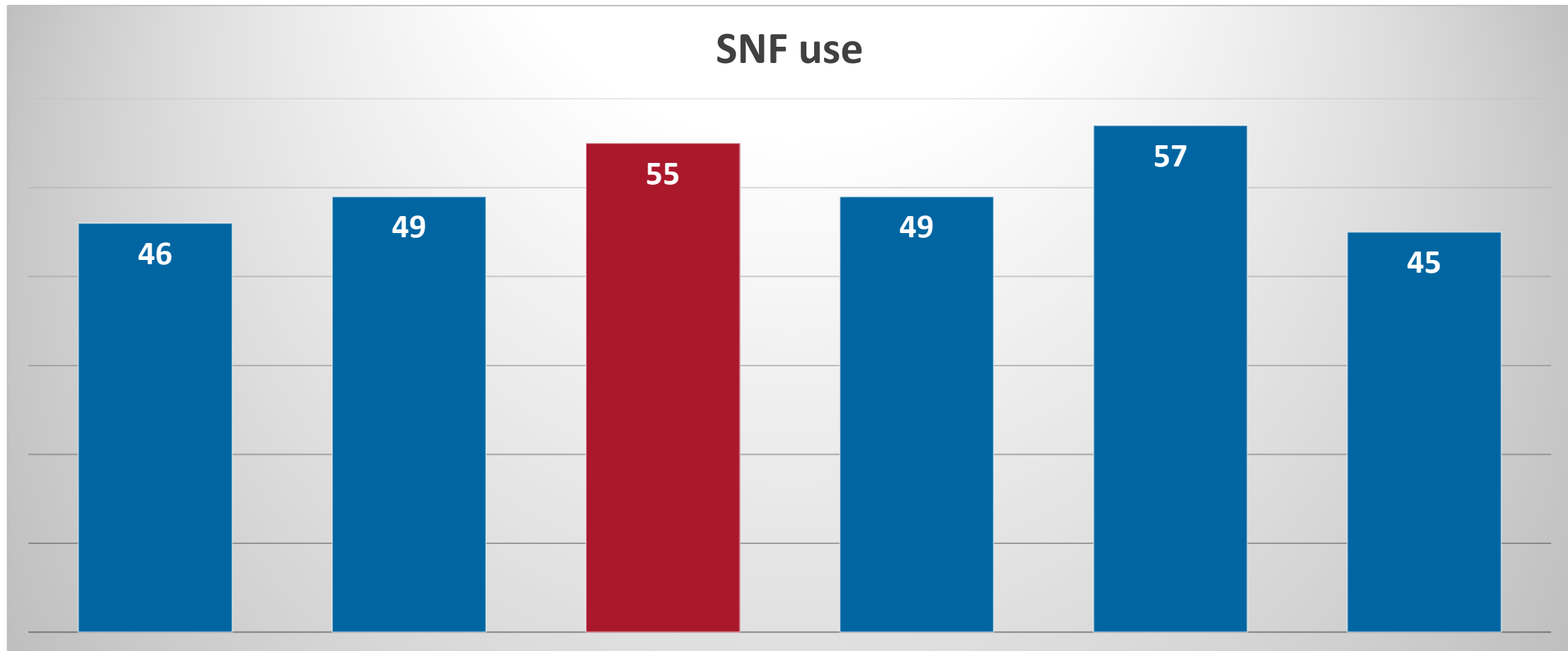


Acute hospital admissions

Hospital admits per 1000

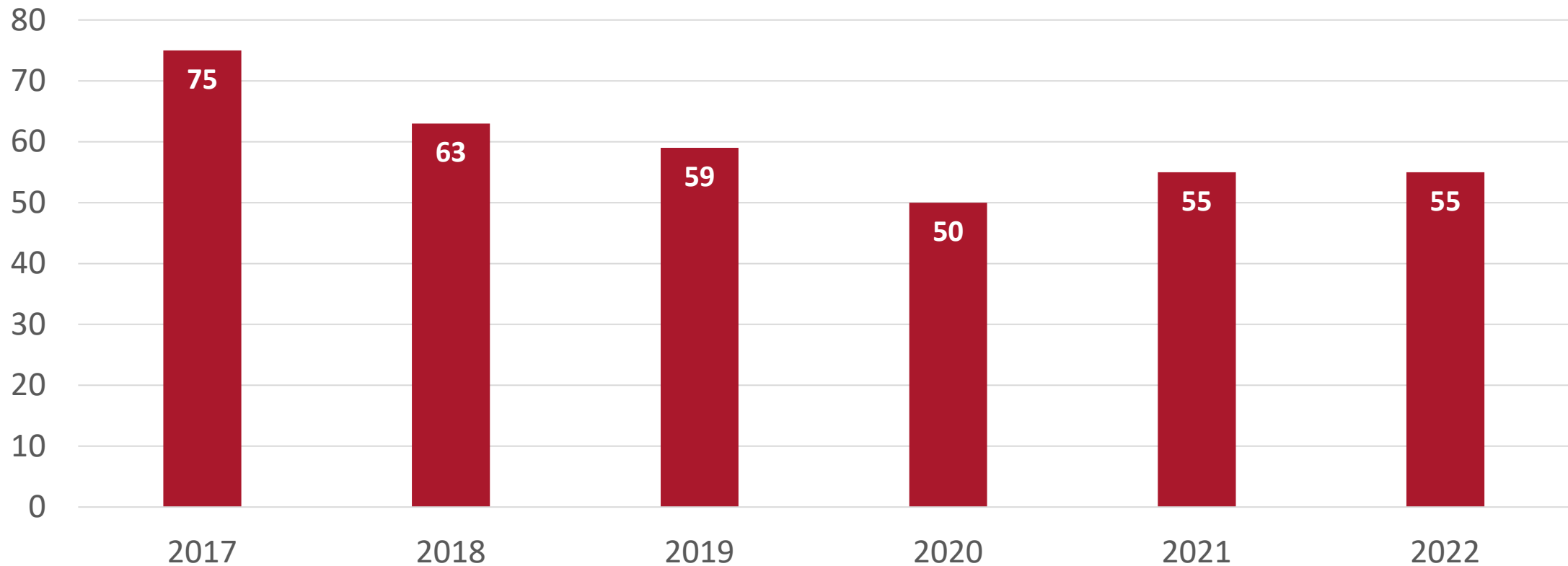


2021 Skilled nursing facility admissions per 1000



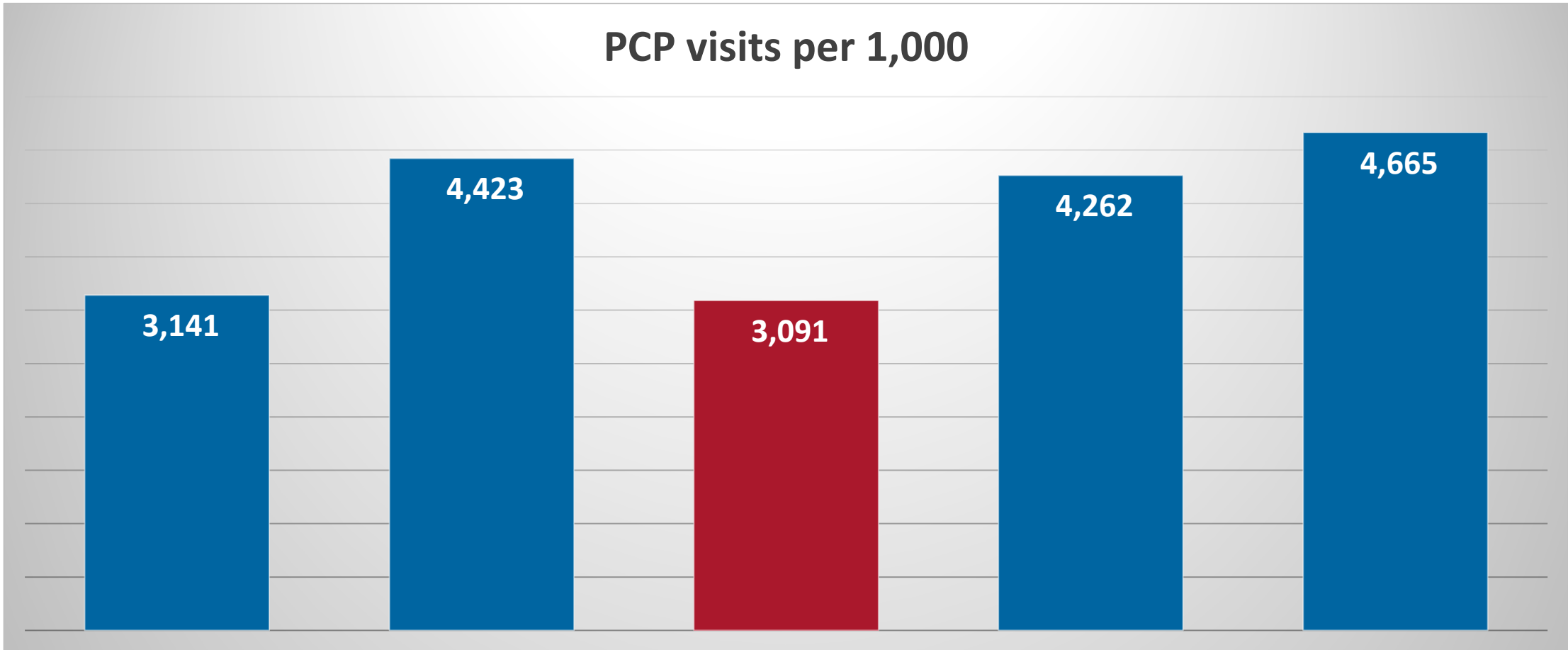
Skilled nursing facility admissions

SNF admissions per 1,000



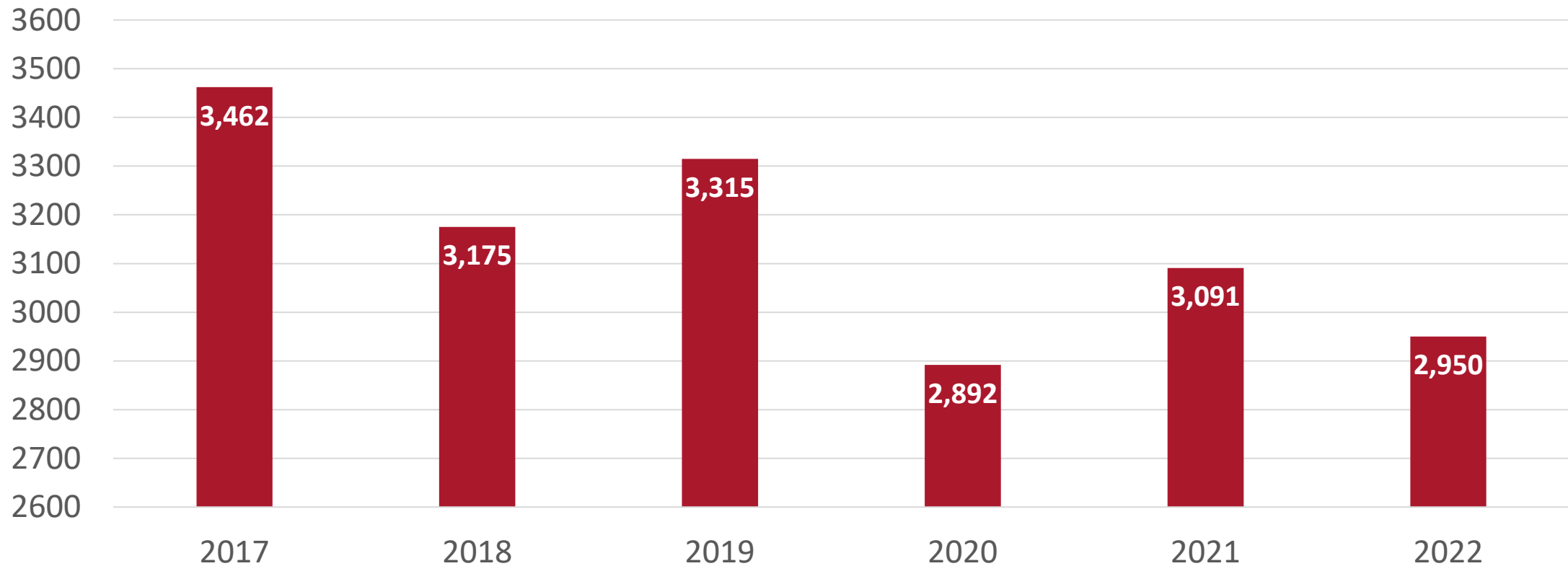
Visits with a primary care physicians

PCP visits per 1,000

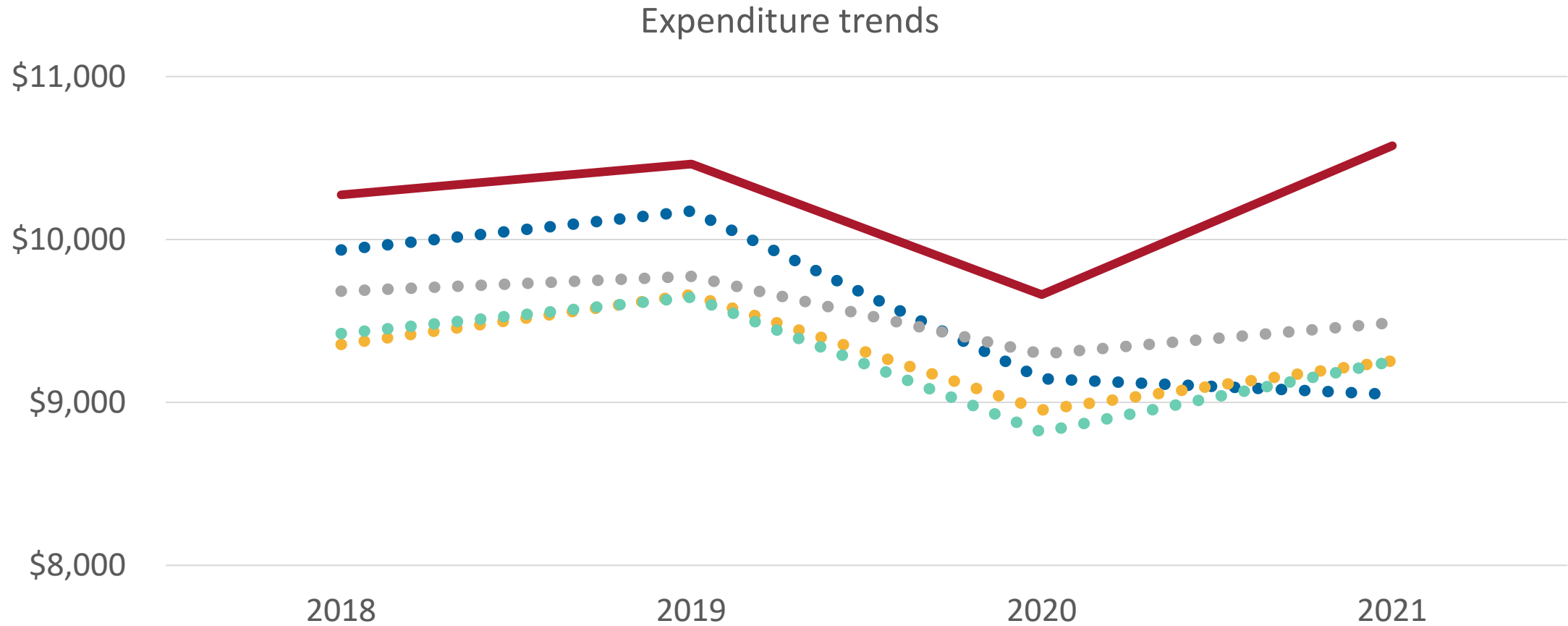


Visits with a primary care physicians

PCP visits per 1000

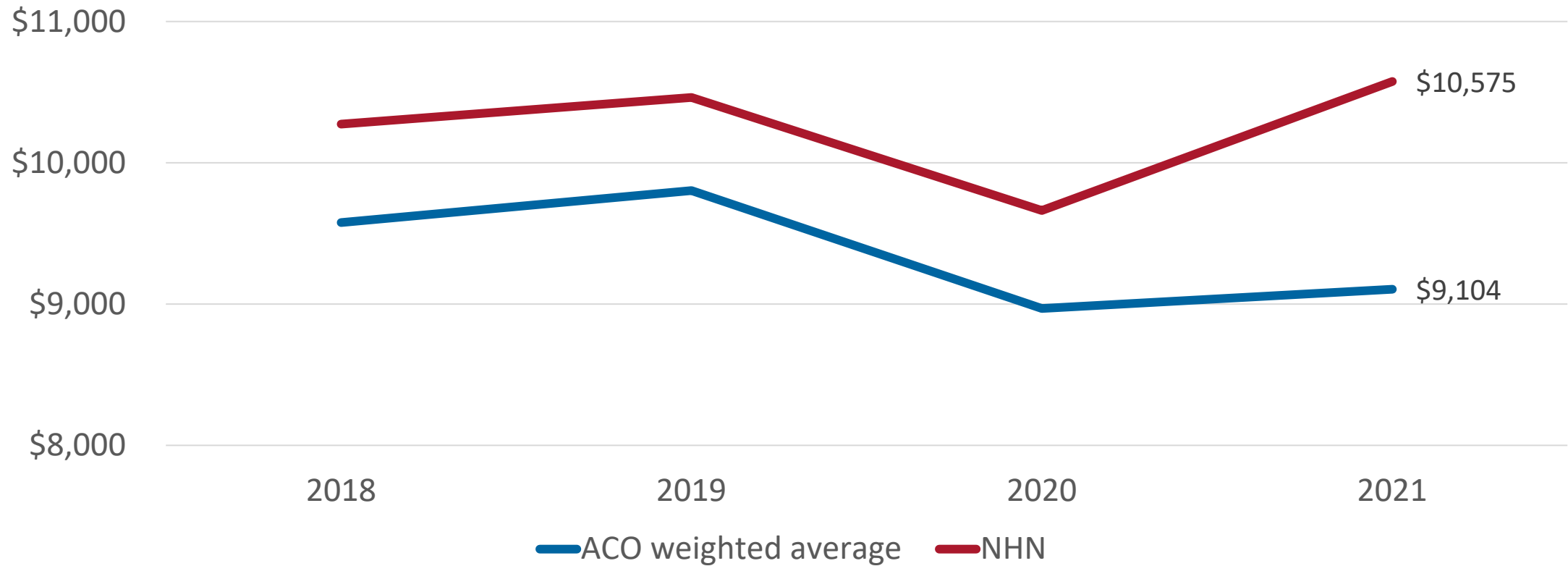


Expenditure trends of our regional ACO peers



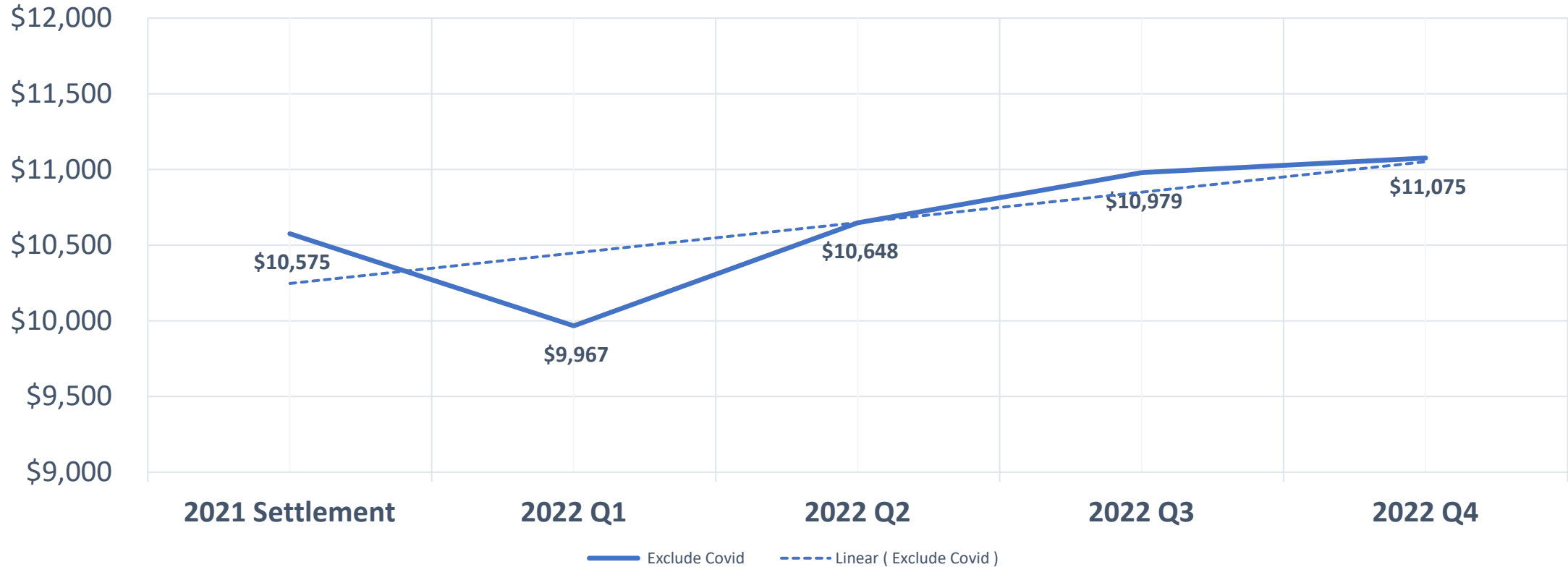
Weighted average expenditure trends of our peers
